

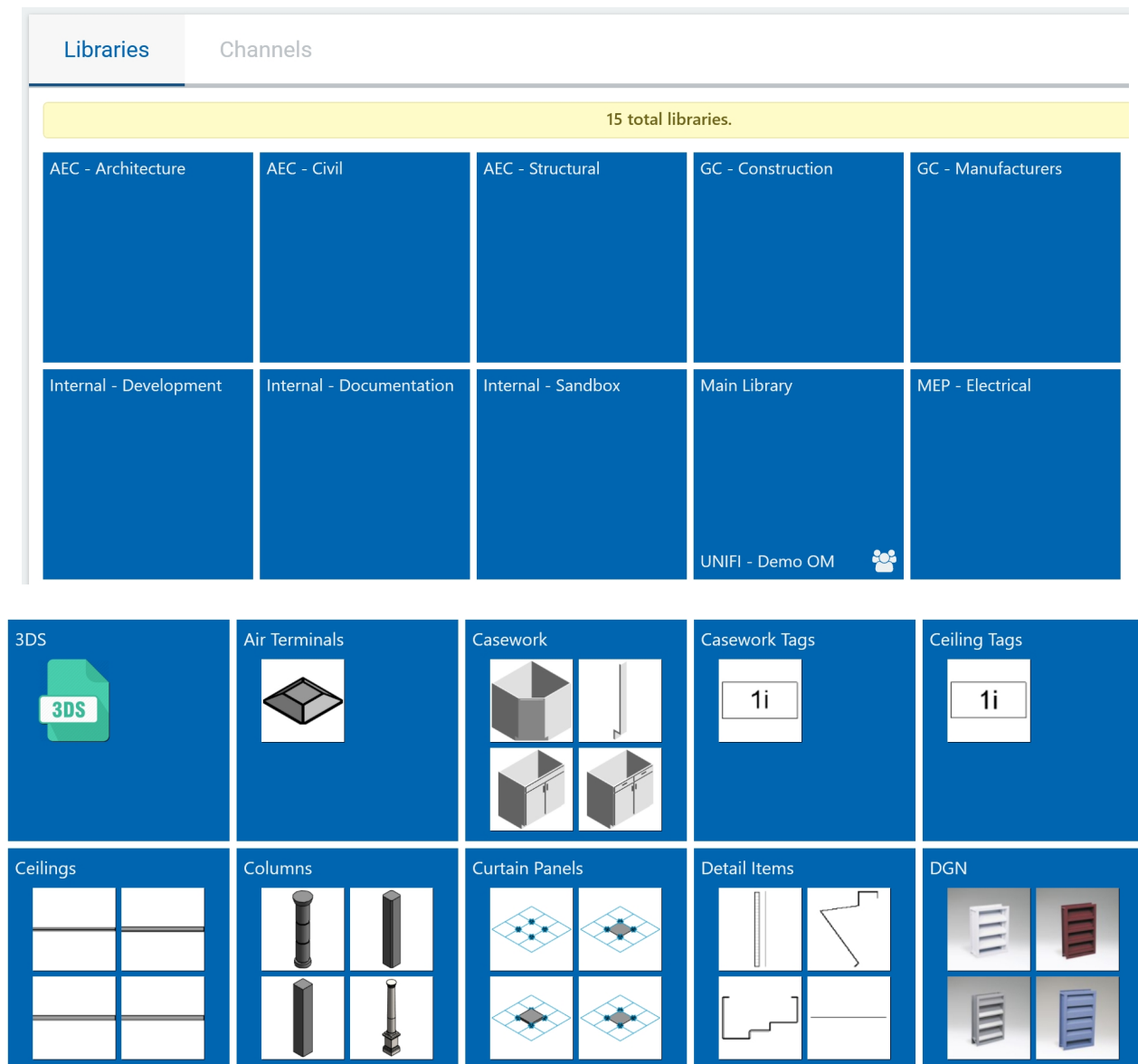
The Three Main Ways to Find Content in UNIFI

Browse Content

The Browse Content feature allows you to find content that is sorted by libraries and categories.
